Welcome To DaySpring

DaySpring Services of Arkansas, LLC, is a company dedicated to serving the mental health needs of children, adolescents and adults across the state of Arkansas.

The outpatient, case management, and day treatment programs are accredited by CARF and certified by the Division of Behavioral Health. Referrals to the treatment programs may come from physicians, schools, service agencies or court, and self referrals.

DaySpring is committed to delivering mental health treatment/services to consumers/clients by providing services where the consumer/client is located. The services may be provided in the clinic, the client's home or school, nursing homes, residential care facilities or assisted living facilities. The goal of each service is to assist the consumer/client in achieving optimal functioning in their daily lives.

Crisis services are provided 24 hours-a-day, seven days a week. Each individual's treatment process is guided and monitored by a multi-disciplinary staff. All aspects of service delivery are monitored to assure quality treatment and ethical business practices.

Currently, DaySpring service sites operate throughout the state.

Outpatient Services

Dayspring Outpatient services include individual psychotherapy, family psychotherapy, group psychotherapy for children, adolescents and/or adult clients, medication management, school-based services and nursing home services.

These services address numerous client needs such as psychiatric illness, emotional and behavioral problems, family and interpersonal relationships, life span issues, situational stressor's and trauma resolution. The specialty programs such as the school-based services provided during or after school focus on the behavioral and mental health needs of school-aged clients, while working closely with the client's family and school personnel.

Case Management

Case Management services provide individualized support focused on improving client self-sufficiency. Certified paraprofessional staff members complete a functional assessment and assist in planning, linkage, advocacy, coordination and monitoring of client activities.

Supportive case management services assist clients in improving and maintaining functioning in their home, school and community environments. Dayspring recognizes the importance of each individual developing and utilizing necessary living skills while increasing their independence.

Day Treatment

Day Treatment services are more intensive than outpatient services offering structured, therapeutic programs designed to assist each client in achieving identified treatment goals. Services include individual, family and group psychotherapy, psycho-educational sessions, assistance with daily living skills, social, leisure, nutritional and fitness activities, along with medication management and monitoring if needed. Typically day treatment programs are offered at least four days a week and at least three hours a day.

DaySpring Staff

DaySpring services are provided by licensed mental health professionals, psychiatric physicians, nursing staff, and certified paraprofessionals. Quality improvement efforts at DaySpring include on-going training of professional and paraprofessional staff, monitoring for all aspects of company business to meet accreditation, certification, and licensing standards as well as complying with regulations for reimbursement requirements.

Payment for Services

Payment for services is usually covered by Medicare and Arkansas Medicaid insurance with eligibility verified before services begin. Private insurance may also pay for some services. While DaySpring does not directly bill private insurance for services provided, a statement of services will be given to the client for submission to their insurance carrier for fee reimbursement. A sliding scale fee is also available for those without insurance coverage. The staff will discuss the fee scale and any other service payment questions with you.

DaySpring Behavioral Health Services is accredited by CARF, Commission of Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, and licensed by the State of Arkansas Department of Medicaid as an RSPMI provider.
